INSPECTING VETERINARY SURGEON'S CERTIFICATE for **JENNY'S** ON REACHING THEIR 3rd BIRTHDAY

The aim of the Association is to encourage the registration and breeding of sound, healthy animals with few or no physical defects that might affect future generations. This form will assist in identifying animals with such defects, and the MMDA Stud Book will retain the right to refuse Miniature Mediterranean Donkeys which fail this inspection, and we recommend that they not be used in a breeding program.

The veterinary surgeon is asked to use his best judgment to decide if a donkey has any severe or inherited faults to prevent it from being entered into the MMDA stud book with a view to being used for breeding. The veterinary surgeon is asked to complete the form which must be sent to the MMDA registrar with the application form for registration into the Stud Register.

All sections should be completed and boxes ticked where appropriate by an Equine Veterinary Surgeon.
